## Job Description:

Own the Boards is a Knoxville-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to empowering people of all ages through literature and performance. In August 2016, we will be starting a poetry slam initiative for area high school students and are looking to hire two instructors to mentor students.

Instructors will be responsible for

- preparing team building, creative writing, and performance activities for participants
- attending weekly meetings
- maintaining lines of communication with parents and students
- updating social media as needed
- modeling creativing writing and performance techniques
- providing constructive feedback for participants

Instructors will also work with Own the Boards staff to

- promote the program, via in-class performances, when possible
- maintain accurate attendance records of meetings and slams
- administer student surveys at the beginning and ending of each semester

Instructors will be paid \$1200 (pre-tax) per semester, for two semesters. They must also attend an orientation meeting with other instructors, volunteers, and staff at the beginning of August.
